Henna tattooing: Have a short-term henna design applied to your hands or feet.

Smoking shisha: Have a traditional flavor-infused hookah experience.

Falconry Display: Watch a falconry demonstration to learn about the craft's historical significance in the area.

Entertainment: Enjoy live performances of traditional dances like tanoura and fire shows, as well as belly dancing, which will liven up the evening.

Dinner will be served buffet-style and will include both Arabian and international cuisine. Try some of the salads, grilled meats, snacks, and desserts.





Stargazing: The desert has little light pollution, so you may be able to study the night sky and take in all the splendor of the stars.
